ISGVF Reflection

How the Muslim should Respect towards his Parents - Respecting Parents, in the light of Quran

Our life is a gift from Allah (SWT) and is enhanced by sacrifices and hard work of our parents. They nurtured, fed, clothed, protected and cared for us. This is why Allah gave them the honorable status. The position of parents, and the mutual obligation and responsibilities has been mention in Quran and sayings of Prophet Muhammad (pbuh). Reference to parents has been made at least 15 times in the Holy Quran some of the references are as follows:

1. "Your Lord has decreed that you worship none but Him, and that you be kind to parents whenever one or both of them attain old age in your life, say not to them of contempt, nor repel them, but address them of honor and lower to them the wing of humility, out of mercy and say, 'My Lord, bestow on them your mercy, as they brought me up (dearly) during my childhood'" Sura17. Al – Isra, verse: 23-24

2."And we have commanded man (to be good) to his parents: In weakness and hardship his mother bore him, and in two years (after) was his weaning (So the command of Allah is), Show thankfulness to Me and to your parents: To Me is (your final) Destination"
Sura 31,verse: 14

3.Say "Come, I will tell you what Allah (SWT) has commanded for you". Do not make partners with Him. Be good to your parents. Sura 6 Al- An'am verse, 151

4.Prophet Nuh prayed to Allah, "My Lord forgive me, my parents, all who enter my house in faith, and (all) believing men, and believing women." Sura 71 Nuh, verse, 28

Respecting Parents, in the light of Hadith

Hazrat Abu Abdur Rehman Abdullah Bin Mas'ud(R.A.A) says that he asked the Holly Prophet(pbuh) which action is most favorite with Allah the Almighty, He (pbuh) answered: "Performing the salat (offering Prayer) in time. I asked : Thereafter? He (pbuh) said Good treatment of parents. I Submitted then which next? He (pbuh) said: Fighting or struggling in the way of Allah. (Bukhari and Muslim).

Hazrat Abu Hurairah (R.A.A) Relates that a man came to the Holy Prophet (S.A.S) and asked: "O Messenger of Allah which person of all the people is best entitled to kind treatment and the good companionship from me? He (pbuh) answered your mother. The man asked: And then your mother. And after her? He (pbuh) your mother. And after her? The Holy Prophet (pbuh) said your

father.” (Bukhari and Muslim) This obviously shows that where care and kind treatment are concerned, the claim of mother is greater than that of the father, at childbirth and in the bring-up of children she plays a vital role in their lives. In one Hadith the Holy Prophet (pbuh) has clearly stated that “Paradise lies under the feet of the mother”. In reference to Father in another Hadith is mention “God’s pleasure is in the pleasure of the father, and God’s displeasure is in the displeasure of the father”.

Hazrat Abu Hurairah (R.A.A) relates that the Holy Prophet (pbuh) said: ‘May his nose be rubbed in dust, May his nose be rubbed in dust ,may his nose be rubbed in dust i.e May he be humiliated,(He (pbuh) said this thrice), who found his parents , one or both, approaching old age, but did not enter Paradise,(by serving them). (Muslim)

When Parents should not be obeyed:

“And we have enjoined kindness to parents from men: But if they (either one) try hard to make you join (anything) with me (others for worship) anything about which you have no knowledge, do not obey them.(All of) you have to return to Me(Allah), and I will tell you (the truth) of all that you did”. Sura 29 .Al-Ankabut, verse 8. If anyone’s parents are polytheists, and they want him to follow their faith he or she should refuse, but he or she should continue to be kind and respectful to them as mention in following Hadith

Hazrat Asma’s bint Abu Baker Siddiq (R.A.A) relate: My mother came to Medina from Mecca to see me ,while she was still an unbeliever. She had come to demand something from me. I enquired from the Holy Prophet (S.A.S): ‘My mother has come to me to see me and she is expecting something from me. May I oblige her? He(pbuh) said : ‘Yes be kind to your mother’. (Bukhari and Muslim)

Parent’s Rights after their Death

We should pray to Allah(SWT) to have mercy on them after their death which brings comfort in their grave and will be a source of elevation and forgiveness for them. It is a religious obligation for the children to fulfill them as mention in the following Hadith:

“When a person dies, all his deeds come to an end except three things (1) ongoing charity. (2) beneficial knowledge(which he has left behind). (3) or a righteous child who pray for him. (Reported by at-tirmidhi with good chain of transmission).

We pray to Allah (SWT) that he guide us to be respectful, kind, and obedient to our parents (Ameen).Let us also make dua that we be patient, kind, and show our love to our children and guide them their lives according to Quran and sunnah (Ameen).May Allah (SWT) accept our efforts and reward us, both in this world and in the Hereafter (Ameen).
