

Phase-1: Timeline & Criteria

ISGVF Masjid will be open for all five daily prayers starting Monday June 22nd.

All attendees are requested to strictly follow CDC guidelines and social distancing policies.

Attendees will be allowed on a first come first serve basis, once Iqama is called the doors will be closed



Procedures



- Entry to the mosque will be limited to a **first come first** serve basis
- 1 person only will be allowed to enter at a time.
- Attendees will have to form a line at the entrance each standing 6 feet apart.
- All attendees **must** bring your own Personal prayer rug, wear mask, gloves etc.
- All attendees **must** use plastic bags for placing shoes in it and keep with them.
- All attendees **must** come with wadhu, as wadhu areas and restrooms will be closed.
- All attendees **must** keep a 6feet distance between each other in prayer areas.
- Children under the age of 13 are **NOT** permitted to enter the Masjid.

Procedures (Continued)

- Anyone who has been ill with cold-like symptoms (coughing, sneezing, congestion, runny nose, etc.) within the last 2 weeks or has been in contact with ill or confirmed COVID-positive individuals are requested not to attend the Salah to avoid spreading infection.
- Those who are most vulnerable (people over the age of 65 and/or with pre-existing health conditions) are strongly advised to stay home and pray.
- No socialization will be allowed at any point of time in the Masjid premises
- Masjid will open 15 minutes before each Salah/Iqamah and will be closed 15 minutes after the end of Fard prayer.
- All attendees must leave immediately after the end of Fard prayer
- Masjid will remain locked between each Salah
- ISGVF cannot assume any liability of individuals who may contract COVID-19



Individuals with a temperature above 99.9F are recommended to stay home
